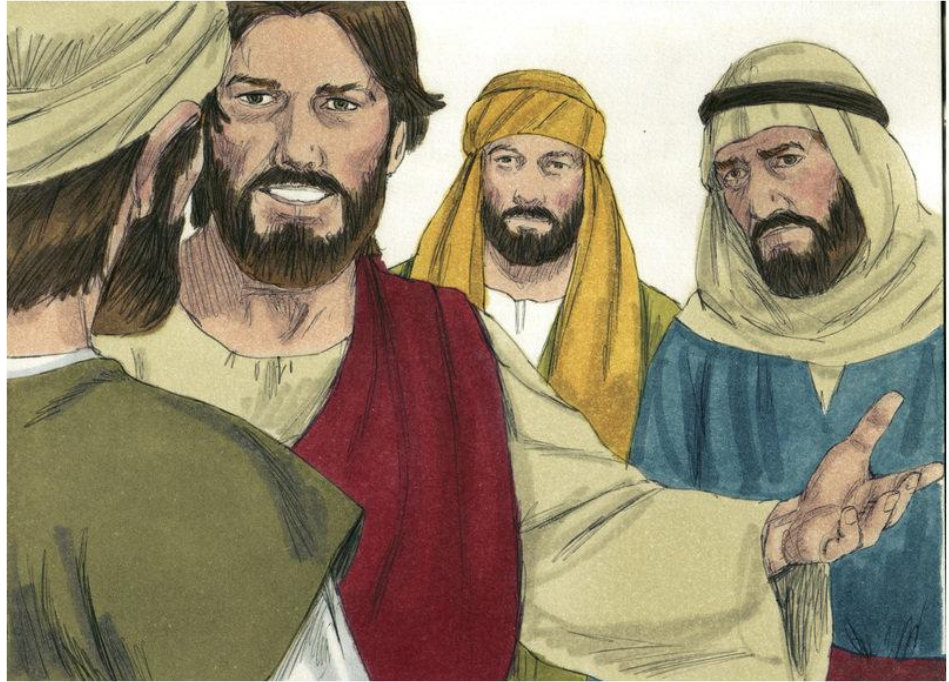
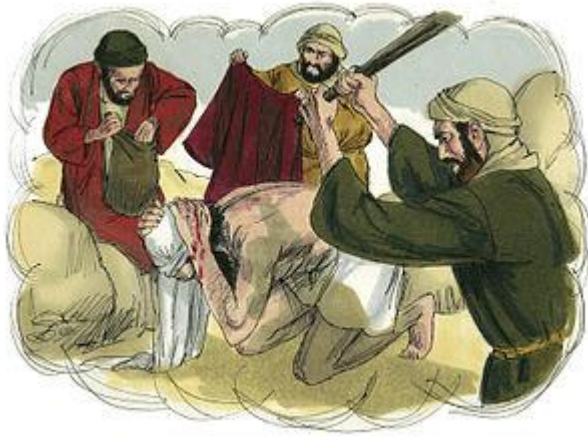

**THERE IS A SPECIAL TABLE CLOTH THAT IS PUT ON THE ALTAR AND A SPECIAL CUP AND PLATE AND WINE AND WATER TO CHANGE INTO THE BLOOD OF JESUS AND HOSTS TO BE CONSECRATED INTO JESUS' BODY.**

# **EUCCHARISTIC PRAYERS AND RESPONSES**

**THE PRIEST FOLLOWS THE WORDS THAT JESUS SPOKE AT THE LAST SUPPER TO CHANGE THE WATER AND WINE INTO HIS BLOOD AND THE UNLEAVENED BREAD INTO HIS BODY. WE RESPOND WITH THE ACCLAMATION AND THE AMEN**

**ONCE THE TRANSUBSTANTIATION IS DONE...**

**WHATTTTTTTTT!!!!!!! DOES THAT MEAN??????**

TRANSUBSTANTIATION IS THE CONVERSION OF THE  
SUBSTANCE OF THE EUCHARIST ELEMENTS INTO THE BODY  
AND BLOOD OF CHRIST AT THE CONSECRATION, ONLY THE  
APPEARANCE OF BREAD AND WINE ARE STILL REMAINING



## **AFTER THE CONSECRATION WE RECEIVE JESUS....**

WHEN WE RECEIVE JESUS AT COMMUNION TIME WE NEED TO BE REVERENT AND PRAYERFUL. WE DON'T SAY YOU HAVE TO FOLD YOUR HANDS LIKE YOU DID DURING YOUR COMMUNION BUT WE ALL SHOULD FOLD OUR HANDS AND WHEN THE PRIEST GIVES US JESUS WE SHOULD MAKE A CUP OF OUR HANDS TO RECEIVE HIM AND IMMEDIATELY CONSUME THE HOST.
